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The "Cap des Palmes" is a robust and comfortable aluminum sailboat, designed from the outset for navigation in high latitudes by the Dutch shipyard Jongert.

The yacht has several living areas and a deck saloon that allows you to sail in polar conditions while remaining well sheltered.

It is equipped with all the necessary equipment to sail comfortably and in complete autonomy and the three guest cabins each have a spacious bathroom.

The boat is completely insulated and equipped with a highly effective heating.

It is also an environmentally friendly vessel thanks to its hydrogenation system that allows its battery bank to be charged without the use of fossil energy and its wastewater treatment unit that limits discharges into sensitive areas.

The crew has its own saloon and two cabins to respect the privacy of the guests.

To stay connected with loved ones, the boat is equipped with **high-speed internet via Starlink** and a backup Iridium antenna.

French “art de vivre”

Historically, the "Cap des Palmes" was a banana cargo ship, requisitioned by General de Gaulle to represent Free France in the Pacific. This ship distinguished itself in particular during the landing on Guadalcanal, under the command of Commander Bernard Ybert, Briec's great-uncle.

A symbol of resilience and a certain « French art de vivre », we are now perpetuating this heritage with the "new Cap des Palmes". This elegant yacht combines comfort and refinement, with exceptional cuisine prepared exclusively from fresh products. On board, French elegance is expressed through every detail, enhanced by an exceptional wine cellar, where passengers can enjoy a selection of carefully chosen fine wines. Each cruise becomes a unique experience, taking our guests to faraway and unprecedented destinations.
